For the 2011 fair season, IAFE is again teaming up with associate member Events Unlimited to make it possible for IAFE member fairs to have access to great activity learning stations at no cost to the fairs. However, the fair will be responsible for shipping charges one way and any additional supplies. Again this year, the stations will included "Farmer for a Day", "Milk Maker", and "Corn is Everywhere" displays.

The "Farmer for a Day" will help educate children in important farming tasks such as gathering eggs, picking apples, and digging potatoes. While completing this activity, the children are seeing, touching, and experiencing where their food comes from.

The "Milk Maker" will show children where milk comes from and that cows are also responsible for some of their favorite foods. The children will be able to milk a life-like cow and learn how dairy products get to their table.

The "Corn is Everywhere" will help families learn that corn can be found in many everyday products. Fairgoers will enjoy the corn "plinko" game, tossing corn bags and more.

Enclosed you will find brochures which describe both stations being offered to member fairs. On the reverse side of this memo, is an application for participation which must be returned to the IAFE office no later than 45 days prior to your fair.

Scheduling of the stations will be on a first come first serve basis, pending availability and last year's status. However those fairs that applied in 2010 and did not receive the station will be given first priority if they apply in 2011.
